2. What are the main legal rules?

We inform you that your personal data will be processed by the University of Szeged as data controller

- in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC
- and Act CXII of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information

The purpose of collecting your personal data during the registration (by e-mail) is to assess the number of applicants in advance, to ensure that participants can attend the online summer school.

4.3. Certificate data

The purpose of the collection your personal data to issue certificates on the participations and achievements.

If participants from Szeged would use it to transfer it for accepting a special course officially in Neptun, the public task regulation is applied.

4.4. Group photo processing

The purpose of making group photo to provide information on the SSIP 2020 webpage. This is not mandatory for participants. Sending it via email it is a consent to use it for group photo.

What kind of data?	Why do we add it?	What is the lawful basis of processing?	How long do we store it?
Personal photo	To identify the person during and after the summer school	on consent	until the voluntary consent is withdrawn

Voluntary consent may be withdrawn at any time. We inform you that the withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of data processing before the withdrawal. In the erasure request, we will ask you for the same information as you used to give consent.

5. To whom is the data transferred?

5.1. Giving over of data within the organization

No data transfer.

5.2. Transfer of data outside the organization

Your personal data will be transferred to Google Inc., a data processor, in a third country. Google processes your data in the United States. The adequacy of the protection of personal data in this case is determined by the so-called agreement between the United States and the European Union so-called Privacy Shield is providing. 6. Do we resort to a data processor?

We use Google Inc as a data processor.

7. Do we collect information about you from another person?

Yes. We collect the information about you if is necessary from your supervisor to identify you, and the lawful base of our data processing is based on to issue a certificate for the participant.

9. What are the legal consequences for non-disclosure?

The failure of providing data voluntarily shall have no adverse legal effect.

10. What are your rights during the program?

You have the rights below for SSIP 2020:

1. right to be informed – you have the right to ask for information on the processing of your personal data.
2. right of access by the data subject – you have access to your personal data we process.
3. right to rectification – should you find inaccuracies in your personal data processed by us, you have the right to ask for rectification.
4. right to erasure – if there is no other lawful basis for data processing, you can ask for the erasure of your personal data.
5. right to object – you have the right to object against data processing based on public task at any time.
6. right to restrict processing – you have the right to ask for the restriction of the processing of your personal data, for example after you find inaccuracies in your personal data, you can ask for restriction of processing while the University of Szeged is checking the data.
7. right to legal remedy – every data subject has the right to legal remedy in case of an infringement.
